

Grade 6 Student Supply List

PLEASE TRY TO HAVE SUPPLIES FOR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL (ESPECIALLY BINDERS AND DIVIDERS), AS WE LABEL EVERYTHING WITHIN THE FIRST COUPLE OF DAYS. BEGINNING THE YEAR ORGANIZED IS VERY IMPORTANT.

- Reuse any left over supplies from last year, if you can
- We encourage students to go to the "Dollar Store" for as many items as possible (pencils tend to be less quality items)
- Avoid any "toy-like" supplies
- Please note: any larger sizes than listed for these binders will not fit in desks
- Flexible plastic covers also help save space
- A "clean out" of work in binders is recommended at the end of each term or unit
- Color-coding is not an absolute MUST, just where possible just to make it easier for students to "grab and go"
- Label EVERYTHING you can
- Please keep some pencils/paper/erasers home and give new ones out throughout the year or your child will not have enough to end the year.

- 2 - 2" ringed Binders (Red-Math, Blue – English)
- 1 – 1-1.5" ringed Binder (Black – Band)
- 6 duotangs (can be recycled) (Home Reading (Blue), SS (Yellow), Sci (Red), Health (Green), Math (Black), 1 extra - FRENCH)
- 1 - 250 sheet pkg looseleaf
- 4 pkgs of dividers
- 1 pkg of clear page protectors
- HOMEWORK AGENDA (Any calendar/notebook with space to write daily homework and reminders)
- 1 - coil **large** scrapbook
- 20 pencils (label the package). ONLY SEND IN 5 TO START IN SEPTEMBER
- Encased pencil sharpener
- 4 pens - 2 blue, 2 red (no gel pens please)
- 2 black sharpies
- 2 highlighters (different colors)
- 1 pkg colored pencils
- 1 ruler (30 cm)
- 3 erasers (ONLY SEND IN 1 FOR SEPTEMBER)
- 3 large glue sticks, 1 small bottle liquid glue (ONLY SEND 1 IN FOR SEPTEMBER)
- Scotch tape
- 1 roll of packing tape (boxing tape)
- 1 pair scissors
- Pencil case – soft cover
- 1 pkg of self-stick labels (Dollar Store)
- 1 math set
- 1 calculator (only needs basic functions)
- 2 pkg. post it notes (I will collect 1 package at beginning of year to be used in SSR)
- 1 large box of Kleenex or more if you want (we ran out this year!)
- Please remember to bring your \$10.00 Fine Arts/Exploratory fee if you have not done so already

Phys. Ed. Supplies

- T-shirt
- Shorts (no zippers or buckles)
- Sneakers (indoors - non-marking soles)
