

Extra Curricular Activities

Coldbrook and District School believes in the "Fair Play" code. Therefore, all coaches, student athletes, parents, officials and volunteers are expected to adhere to the following principles:

- Respect at all time for participants, coaches, officials, teammates, spectators, opponents, administrators and volunteers.
- Sportsmanship prior to, during and following the activity, demonstrating modesty in victory and composure in defeat.
- Knowledge of all rules, whether written or unwritten, and commitment to the spirit of the rules.
- Opportunity for all to participate in sport. We will provide enough teams to continue to support our no-cut policy.
- Participation in a manner that reflects: having fun, making friends, improving skills and performing your personal best.
- All school and AVRSB policies will be respected.

Guidelines for Sport Team Participation

Everyone is responsible to ensure that the principles are familiar, understood and complied with. An offense would necessitate a meeting with the coach and staff advisor, and perhaps school administration.

Team members must maintain a successful academic standing and a positive behavioral school record in order to be a school representative on a team. Homeroom teachers will inform the school administration if a student's athletics position should be reviewed.

If class time is missed due to athletics, all missed work must be completed to the satisfaction of the teacher.

Attendance at each practice is mandatory. A student athlete must provide a reasonable written excuse to the coach and staff advisor if a practice or game is to be missed. Examples of reasonable excuses include medical appointments, extra-help, and funerals. Examples of unreasonable excuses include hair appointments, babysitting and homework.

Students in both sport and band must split or alternate practices. Both the band instructor and coach must be informed of every scheduling conflict. Students in both activities are required to attend all dress rehearsals, concerts, important play-off practices, and games. These days will not be split. If a conflict occurs, the band instructor and coach will make the final decision.

In order to attend practice or to participate in a game, students must attend school on the day of the event. In other words, if a student is not in school or does not participate in a school function on that day, they will not be permitted to participate in the athletic activity.
